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GENERAL GUIDELINES

Teachable Spirit: One of the most important requirements for acceptance is that each student has a teachable spirit. Students do not need to be perfect, just willing to learn.

Dating: During enrollment in MAMC, dating is not permitted. The purpose of the program is to give oneself to God without any distractions. This time is to be utilized to further establish a standard of intimacy with Jesus that will last a lifetime. We're confident when you separate yourself you will find that the reward will far outweigh the sacrifice.

Vacation: There are limited personal breaks during the program. Examples: graduations, weddings, funerals, etc. We ask that the program is valued as an uninterrupted season of consecration. MAMC will offer Thanksgiving vacation, Christmas vacation, and an extended weekend for Spring break.

Health Insurance: Each applicant should provide his or her own health insurance coverage. Neither MAMC nor Victory World Church will be able to cover any medical expenses.

Vehicle: We recommend that each student have access to a reliable vehicle throughout the term. All students who do not have a vehicle are still held responsible for their own transportation needs (i.e. punctuality to meetings, classes, etc.). You are responsible to insure your vehicles as required by Georgia State Law. Students are expected to familiarize themselves with and abide by all Georgia State traffic laws.

Personal expenditures: Each student must have sufficient funds to cover any personal expenses that they may incur throughout the term. Since students will not be allowed to seek outside employment due to time commitments during their stay, it is suggested that each student would have at least \$25 in personal spending money per week (to cover car, laundry, food, and any other personal expenses).

Metro Atlanta Master's Commission's Foundational Commitment:
